Re: Graduation and end of year information

Dear Parents and Guardians,

We hope that this letter finds you well. We wanted to take this opportunity to provide you with information on our plans for the 8th grade graduation exercises at Netcong Elementary School.

We are planning for our graduation ceremony on Thursday, June 15, 2023, at 6:00 pm. Students should be dressed to impress for our ceremony. We ask that boys wear collared shirts and dress pants (ties are optional) and that girls wear dress pants or a skirt or dress. All clothing must comply with our school dress code.

8th graders who rented locks may return them to Mrs. Dilley on June 9, 2023. Locks must be in working condition to receive a refund of \$5.00 per lock. It would be helpful if students write their combination on a piece of paper and attach it to their lock before they return it.

We will be holding the 8th grade breakfast sponsored by the PTA and a school sponsored picnic lunch on June 8, 2023. The breakfast will be held at Rose's Diner in Netcong from 8:30am-10:30am. The picnic lunch will be held outdoors on our campus, weather permitting. Students will receive their yearbooks on the day of the breakfast and picnic and will be participating in some fun activities.

Graduation practices will take place on June 6, 7, 8 and 13, 2023 during school hours. Students will practice for both indoor and outdoor ceremonies.

Students will return all Chromebooks, chargers, textbooks, and other school owned materials on Monday, June 12, 2023. Per our board policy, diplomas may be withheld if materials are not returned and fees and fines are not paid.

Finally, the district is printing lawn signs for each member of the class of 2023. The students may take home the lawn signs after the breakfast and picnic on June 8, 2023.
