We are pleased to announce that our annual Morris County Public Safety Youth Academy (MCPSYA) Program will be returning this summer! This program, specifically designed for high-school students, will run from July 31 – August 4, 2023. The MCPSYA is a 5-day program that is open to all Morris County, NJ high-school students entering Grades 9-12 in the fall of 2023. The program is sponsored by the Morris County Board of County Commissioners and is completely free of charge to all students and their families.
