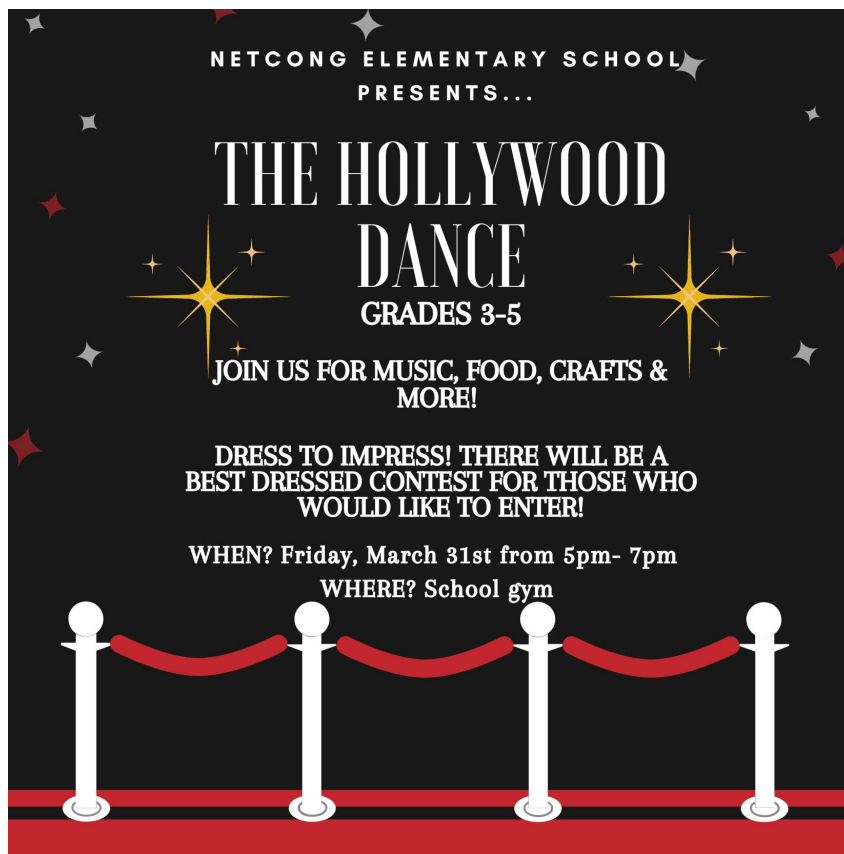
Students of the Month:
